

HER TALK ENRAGED THEM

Mary Turner Taken to Folsom's Bridge and Hanged.

Quitman, Ga., May 19.—Mary Turner, wife of Hayes Turner, was hanged this afternoon at Folsom's bridge, over Little river near Barney.

Hayes Turner was hanged at the Okaploo river in this county last night.

His wife, it is claimed, made statements to-day about the execution of her husband and the people in their indignant mood took exceptions to her remarks as well as her attitude and took her to the river where she was hanged.

This makes five persons lynched in this section as a result of the Smith tragedy at Barney. All of Sidney Johnson's relatives including his mother and father were landed in jail at Valdosta last night. To-night, owing to the increased feeling among the people, the jail is being strongly guarded to prevent trouble.

Besides the chase after Sidney Johnson posses are to-night looking for other negroes in this section and feeling among both whites and blacks seems to be growing more intense.
